### Time to Mail in BoxTops!


Turn-in date is Sunday, October 16th. That allows time to clip, sort, and count them to be mailed and included in the next **BoxTops for Education** payout.

God Tests Abraham's Faith when he asks Abraham to offer Isaac, the son he had waited for all his life, as a sacrifice to God. Abraham's willingness to do this showed that God came first in his heart. Now it was time to find A God-fearing Wife for Isaac. God led Abraham's servant to find Rebekah who agreed to marry Isaac whom she had never met.

Abraham, Isaac, and Rebekah showed their faith by trusting God to guide their lives when the way could not easily be seen. We often find ourselves in situations where there are no easy answers. Through faith we know that God wants only what is good for us.

- ◆ Subtraction is the topic in Math 3 and 4. Third graders learned about the "count up" method of subtraction and fourth graders worked on the trade first method.
- ◆ Fifth graders took a unit 2 test in math.
- ◆ We are discussing the history of oil in social studies.

**Grades 6, 7, and 8****Mr. Bain**

- † Our Science classes are about NASA's space missions since the end of the shuttle program.
