## Facilities Planning Update

Yes, it has been awhile since you heard from the Facility Planning Committee... because there isn't one. But don't despair! We are in the process of taking the next steps.

**To refresh your memory:**

In a nutshell, the committee studied options concerning the present building, the Spring Creek site, and the Hancock School (a.k.a. St. Joe's). First, to dispense with Hancock: the potential of a good price on the school was offset by the significant maintenance needs of the building (brickwork, asbestos, leaks, etc.); and the owner is looking for a buyer, not a lessee. In light of this (and many other considerations!), the facility planning committee recommended that we maintain our current building as a worship facility, improve

its handicap accessibility, and pursue options for a new school building, with Spring Creek as the preferred site.

**Now for an update:**

The current building needs expensive professional brick repointing to preserve the exterior and to put an end to the water damage issues that we deal with on the interior. We submitted a pre-application for legacy funding from the state of Minnesota last fall; however, we have a few items to fix on our own before we can proceed with our request for preservation funds. These mainly involve roofing issues that we cannot address until we see the finer weather of spring. After that, we may hire the preservation architects who prepared our Historic Structure Report



to guide us through the grant application process, and, if we are successful, to handle the administration of the repointing project. This portion of our facility plan continues to creep forward.

**What about handicap accessibility?**

The preservation architects made various plans for improved accessibility in our current building. The best of these involve the demolition of the current school building and the creation of an addition with new bathrooms and a full-size elevator that opens into the sanctuary. Two challenges confront us before we can

proceed: relocation of the school, and funding.

### What's next?

Glad you asked. Right now, we are assembling a committee to address the specific needs of the school, and to move this portion of the facility plan in a positive direction. To offer your services with this endeavor, please see Mr. Shannon Bohme, who has graciously agreed to lead this committee on behalf of the congregation.

### Wait, what about the elephant?

Yes, the elephant in the room is, as usual, funding. We would like to see a stewardship

committee put together to finally tackle this beast head-on. We need to plan for our future in all areas of ministry, using the resources given to us by God in a responsible manner as we "seek first His kingdom." Our facility is one of these resources. You know the others: our time, our talents, our money. All require stewardship on our part. We have received some seed money for both the school and the handicap accessibility portions of the facility plan. A stewardship committee would help us manage donations and ask the following questions: In what order do we fund the

various parts of our plan? What percentage of the total should we collect before we launch any of these projects? Should we take on any debt? How do we balance our ongoing ministry needs with these projects? How do we communicate our needs to the congregation? Anyone interested in being part of the answer should contact Jerry Plitzuweit.

### Are we there yet?

Not without your help. Volunteer for the school facility committee. Or saddle up for the elephant ride. Let's keep the facility plan moving forward. Giddyap!

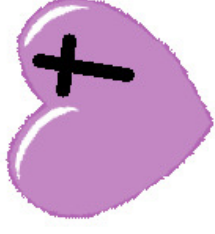

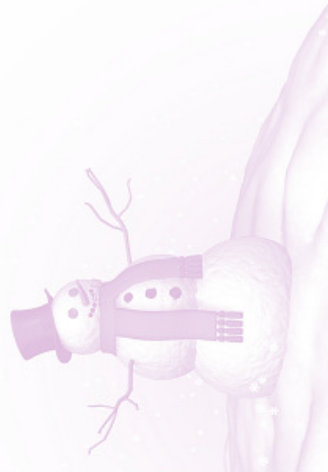
