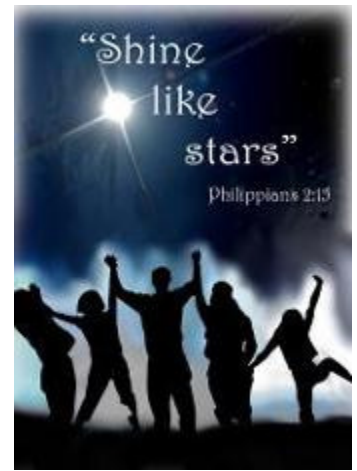

ChristLight This Week

This week we learn that Satan's persecutions cannot destroy God's church.

Acts 5:17-42 tells us The Disciples are Arrested. The Jewish leaders arrested the disciples because they were preaching about Jesus. But during the night, an angel sent from the Lord released them from jail. No matter what the Jewish leaders did, the disciples did not stop teaching about Jesus.

Acts 6:1-8:4 tells us about Stephen. Stephen was one of the seven men chosen by the disciples to care for the Christians in Jerusalem, who were poor. God blessed Stephen and his work, but the Jewish leaders became so angry that they stoned him to death. Just before his death, God gave Stephen a wonderful vision of heaven. After Stephen's death, the Holy Spirit continued to bless the Christians with courage to tell others about Jesus.

The early Christians faced jail and even death as they continued to spread the Word of God. What sometimes prevents us from spreading God's Word today? Most often we are only afraid of what someone may think or say about us. What a small price to pay for doing the Lord's work! Let's ask God to give us the opportunities to witness for Him and the courage to do so.
